On November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at approximately 2:58 pm, the Ithaca Police Department was dispatched to a reported motor vehicle crash involving a pedestrian on Meadow Street at the intersection with South Street. It was reported that the collision involved a dump truck and a pedestrian. The Ithaca Fire Department and Bangs Ambulance also responded to the scene.

The pedestrian who was struck was conscious and was tended to by Bangs Ambulance personnel. The pedestrian was subsequently transported to a local hospital for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

Ithaca Police Officers conducted an investigation on scene including speaking with witnesses in the area. It was determined that the dump truck was turning off of South Street northbound onto South Meadow Street when it struck the pedestrian who was crossing South Meadow Street in the crosswalk.

The driver of the dump truck was found to be at fault and was ticketed.

People arrested by the Ithaca Police Department are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
