On November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at approximately 8:15 pm the Ithaca Police Department was dispatched to a report of a physical dispute in the 800 block of North Cayuga Street. It was reported that multiple persons were hitting a male who was on the ground. It was further reported that one of the persons was armed with a baseball bat.

Ithaca Police officers that arrived on scene located three injured persons. The involved persons all sustained various levels of overall injury and all three had sustained stab wounds. Ithaca Police Officers conducted the initial investigation on scene, which included speaking with involved parties and witnesses. This led to the discovery that one of the involved males had forced his way into a multi-dwelling building in the 800 block of North Cayuga Street. The male was confronted by the occupants and a physical altercation ensued.

The three males were transported to regional trauma centers for medical treatment, however, none of the injuries are believed to be life threatening at this time.

The investigation is currently ongoing. The Ithaca Police Department was assisted at the scene by the Ithaca Fire Department, Bangs Ambulance and NYSP Forensic Investigation Unit.
