How to Use This Review

This Review catalogs the contents of forty-nine (49) files containing police officers' body worn camera ("BWC") footage and two (2) files containing stationary camera footage that record three arrests made in the afternoon of October 22, 2020, and subsequent demonstrations outside of the Ithaca Police Department ("IPD")'s headquarters that afternoon, evening, and into the overnight on October 23, 2020. Several additional arrests on charges including unlawful assembly and resisting arrest were made during the later demonstrations and, at one point, a single burst of pepper spray was used to disperse the crowd.

The Review is intended to be used along with the Report of the Mayor's Office concerning the events of October 22-23, 2020 also being released on January 21, 2021. The Review is divided into two parts. Part I provides file numbers, dates, start times, and a title/high level summary of the content of each file. Part II provides the same information, supplemented with specific descriptions of the events recorded in each file. Time markings from within each file for the event being described appear in the column titled "Mark." We have tried to make the "Mark" entries as exact as possible. In some instances, however, it will be helpful to review the footage from a few seconds before and a few seconds after a particular "Mark" entry to observe the described event and its context.

Examples of how the file numbers in this report correspond with the filenames of the .mp4 files being released are:
