



PERMIT TO WALK AN ANIMAL ON THE ITHACA COMMONS

Pursuant to Chapter 157 of the City of Ithaca Municipal Code entitled "Commons", owners and tenants of buildings on the Primary Commons, whose only access is through the Primary Commons may apply for a permit to walk their animal on a leash or in a carrier to and from their residence or building. No more than two (2) permits shall be issued for each residential or commercial unit. This permit is not transferable, and is valid for the duration of the owner's lease or ownership of the premises on the Commons or for a period of one year, whichever is shorter.

For businesses that require the presence of animals to perform the function of the business, animals are limited to the area between the premises and the closest of the three Primary Commons entrances. One permit shall cover the business and all of its customers.

Requirements:

- Copy of current dog license with rabies vaccination information
- Copy of tenant's lease agreement or letter of permission from landlord
- Twenty dollar (\$20) license fee

Animal Owner Agreement:

I hereby acknowledge that I am responsible for my animal at all times, and agree that my animal will not be left unattended at any time. My animal will remain on a leash or in a carrier while on the Commons, and I will only use the travel route identified on this permit. I agree to remove any waste produced by my animal immediately, and to dispose of it in properly designated receptacles. I understand that failure to abide by this permit and the rules set forth in the City of Ithaca Municipal Code may result in revocation of this permit and fines.

Business Owner Agreement:

I hereby agree to provide two (2) animal waste receptacles with lids, within the permitted area. I acknowledge that I am responsible for the disposal of waste within these receptacles. **No dumping is allowed in City trash cans, grates, storm sewers, or other areas.** I agree to provide waste removal tools to my customers at no charge. I understand that I am responsible for the cleaning of any animal urine or feces that is deposited in the permitted area and that failure to abide by this permit and the rules set forth in the City of Ithaca Municipal Code may result in revocation of this permit and fines. I agree to educate my customers on the permitted travel route, and of the other rules of the Commons as they pertain to animals.
