On Wednesday, November 11th, 2020 at about 3:45 PM Ithaca Police were dispatched to a dispute after multiple 911 calls that reported a fight between multiple subjects in the parking lot of the Speedway, with reports that one subject had a sword.

Upon arrival Officers separated all parties and it was determined that a fight broke out related to a domestic dispute between three individuals. During the incident one victim was punched, choked and thrown onto the ground. At some point during the altercation a machete was produced by a female and used to menace another female, as well as puncture the tire to a vehicle.

After investigation, interview of witnesses and collection of evidence 2 persons were subsequently arrested from the incident:

Neyvon Pinckney, 29 years of age from Spencer, NY:

Strangulation in the 2nd Degree: PL 121.12, a Class D Felony

Assault in the 3rd Degree: PL 120.00-(1), a Class A Misdemeanor

Criminal Mischief in the 4th Degree: PL 145.00-(1), a Class A Misdemeanor

Pickney was arraigned in Ithaca City Court by Hon. Judge Wallace and was remanded to TC Jail on \$3000/\$6000 bail.

Jaquela Rice, 20 years of age from Elmira, NY:

Menacing in the 2nd Degree: PL 120.14-(1), a Class A Misdemeanor

Criminal Mischief in the 4th Degree: PL 145.00-(1), a Class A Misdemeanor

Rice was arraigned in Ithaca City Court by Hon. Judge Wallace and was released on her own recognizance.

People arrested by the Ithaca Police Department are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
